The Chelsea Concert Band is a non-competing community band of musicians who come together to share their love of music making. They perform at Council and Civic functions, various Community Functions, on ANZAC day for both the Dawn Service and Mid -Morning Remembrance Service and at 3 Major Concerts per year.

We rehearse on Monday evenings at the L F Payne Hall, Station Street, Chelsea (enter via the door off the roadway between the Police Station and the Hall) SEE BELOW from 7:30 until 9:30pm with a break halfway through. Rehearsals start on the first Monday in February and conclude the Monday following the Chelsea Community Carols (this year that is the 9<sup>th</sup> of December). Board Meetings are held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of every month from February until November. The AGM is also held in November.
